Funds for improvement of primary education

1166 Shri Neeraj Shekhar:

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

(a) the details of funds allocated, released and utilised during 2019-20 and 2020-21 till date for improvement of primary education in the country, year-wise and State-wise;

(b) the details of the number of sanctioned, current and vacant posts of primary teachers as on date, State-wise; and

(c) the details of vacancies of primary teachers filled during 2019-20 and 2020-21 till date, State-wise?

(a): The Department has launched the Samagra Shiksha – an Integrated Scheme for School Education by subsuming the erstwhile Centrally Sponsored Schemes of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA), Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA) and Teacher Education (TE) from 2018-19. It is an overarching programme for the school education sector extending from pre-school to class XII and aims to ensure inclusive and equitable quality education at all levels of school education. The State/ UT-wise details of allocated/proposed central releases and central share released for elementary education under Samagra Shiksha during 2019-20 and 2020-21 (till 31st January, 2021) is at **Annexure-I**.

(b) & (c): Education is in the concurrent list of the Constitution. The recruitment, service conditions and deployment of teachers come under the purview of the State Government/ UT Administration. However, Ministry of Education has been requesting all the State Governments and UT Administrations for filling-up the vacant posts of teachers

and for their rational deployment. The statement showing State / UT-wise details of the number of sanctioned, in-position and vacant posts of elementary teachers for 2019-20 and 2020-21 is at **Annexure-II** and **Annexure-III**, respectively.
