**FUNCTIONAL HOUSEHOLD/ SCHOOL/ ANGANWADI TAP CONNECTIONS**

1530 SHRI PARTAP SINGH BAJWA:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the additional number of functional household tap connections created for the years 2019-20 till date, State-wise;
- (b) the additional number of schools provided with piped water connections for the years 2019-20 till date, State-wise; and
- (c) the total funds released for the aforementioned projects for the years 2019-20 till date, State-wise; and
- (d) the additional number of anganwadis provided with piped water connections for the year 2019-20 till date, State-wise?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR JAL SHAKTI  
(SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

- (a) At the time of launch of Jal Jeevan Mission on 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2019, out of total 18.93 Crore rural households in the country, 3.23 Crore (17%) households had tap water connections. Since then, 4.62 Crore (24.14%) households have been provided with tap water connections. Thus, as on 30.7.2021, out of 19.12 crore households, 7.85 Crore (41.07%) households have provision of tap water supply. State-wise details of households, which have been provided with tap water connections, is at **Annex-I**.
- (b) & (d) A nation-wide campaign to enhance awareness for making provision of piped water supply to all anganwadi centres, ashramshalas and schools on priority was launched on 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2020. State-wise details of schools/ anganwadi centres with tap water connections as reported by States/ UTs on JJM-IMIS is at **Annex-II (a) & (b)**.
- (c) The details of Central fund allocated and drawn by the States/ UTs under Jal Jeevan Mission in 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22, are at **Annex-III**.
