COMMUNAL VIOLENCE IN DELHI

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether there were cases registered where acid had been used in the communal violence in Delhi in February 2020;

(b) if so, the number of persons, gender-wise, who have suffered injuries due to this; and

(c) how many people have lost their eyesight permanently in these acid attacks?

(a) to (c): Delhi Police has reported that two cases have been registered regarding use of acid in the violence that occurred in Delhi in February, 2020 in which six persons (all male) suffered injuries. As per Delhi Police, no person has reported to have lost his eye sight in these acid attacks.
