(a) & (b): The intent of the Government for conducting Census 2021 was notified in Gazette of India on 28th March, 2019. However, due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic, the conduct of Census 2021 and the related field activities have been postponed until further orders.

(c): The Questionnaire for the first phase of Census i.e. Houselisting and Housing Census was notified in the Gazette of India on 9th January, 2020.
