2303. SHRI AYODHYA RAMI REDDY ALLA:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) the status of the implementation and progress of phase 2 of National Cyclone Risk Mitigation Project (NCRMP);

(b) whether Government has provided any assistance in implementation of Early Warning Dissemination Systems (EWDS) under component A and status of infrastructure projects under component B;

(c) the reasons for the extension of the deadline for completion of phase 2 from March 2021 to September, 2022; and

(d) the measure being taken by the Ministry to ensure the completion of phase 2 within the newly extended deadline of September, 2022?

(a) & (b): National Cyclone Risk Mitigation Project Phase-II (NCRMP-II)

covers six coastal States viz. Goa, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala,

Maharashtra and West Bengal having a revised financial outlay of Rs.

2059.83 Crore with revised date of completion as 15th September, 2022.

An amount of Rs. 1650.72 Crore has been released for the project till 28th

February, 2022 and an expenditure of Rs. 1474.46 Crore has been incurred

till 31st December, 2021. For implementation of Early Warning Dissemination System (EWDS) under Component A of the Project, Central Government is providing 100% financial assistance and is under implementation in three (03) project States viz. Goa, Karnataka & Kerala. Central financial assistance for this component is Rs. 126.73 Crore. Details on the status of infrastructure projects under Component B are given in Annexure.

(c): The timeline for completion of the project is extended due to reasons such as non finalization of suitable land by the State Governments, tendering issues, CoVID-19 pandemic.

(d): State Project Implementation Units (SPIUs) have now awarded all works / activities under the project and they are being followed up regularly for completion of project within the scheduled timelines. Project progress is monitored during the Project Steering Committee (PSC) meetings conducted by National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA). State specific project progress is also reviewed and regularly monitored by the Project Director of NCRMP in NDMA.
