**CIVILIANS AND SECURITY PERSONNEL KILLED BY TERRORISTS IN JAMMU
AND KASHMIR**

3907. SHRI SHAKTISINH GOHIL:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of civilians and security personnel killed by terrorists in Jammu and Kashmir from May 2014 to August 2019;

(b) the number of civilians and security personnel killed by terrorists in Jammu and Kashmir during the period from August 2019 to November 2021; and

(c) the reasons for the enhanced terrorists attacks on civilians and security personnel in Jammu and Kashmir?

(a) & (b): The number of civilians and security personnel killed by terrorists in Jammu and Kashmir is as under:

| Period | Civilians | Security personnel |
|--|------------------|---------------------------|
| May, 2014 to 4th August, 2019 | 177 | 406 |
| 5th August, 2019 to November, 2021 | 87 | 99 |

(c): The Government has a policy of zero tolerance against terrorism and there has been substantial decline in terrorist attacks from 417 in 2018 to 255 in 2019, 244 in 2020 and 229 in 2021. A robust security and intelligence grid is in place to prevent any terrorist attack. In addition, day & night area domination, round the clock checking at Nakas, patrolling and proactive operations against terrorists are being carried out.
